

LEGAL NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals will be received at Buehrer Group Architecture & Engineering, Inc., 314 Conant Street, Maumee, OH 43537, until 2:00 pm on July 23, 2026, to be opened immediately thereafter for furnishing the necessary labor, equipment, tools and materials for the new Wood County Health Department – Wood County Community Health Center Northwood School-Based Health Center.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Guarantee and Contract Bond in the amount of 100% of the bid; or a certified check; cashier's check or letter of credit in the amount of 10% of the bid which will require a 100% Performance Bond upon award of the contract. All bids shall be submitted on forms of proposal supplied by the Architect. All bidders, by bidding, agree to pay wages not less than the minimum as determined by the State of Ohio, Department of Industrial Relations, and agree to comply with Executive Order No. 11246 of the President of the United States.

The Wood County Health Department, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities in bidding. No Bidder may withdraw his or her bid for a period of sixty (60) days after bid opening.
